#### □ Sending out the Acceptance Packages (Documents for applying for the visa) : Before 16 June 2023

- The Acceptance Package will include the followings and be sent <u>by email(soft copy)</u>, not by post(hard copy). If you need an original file(hard copy), please let us know.
  - A. Certificate of Admission
  - B. Acceptance Letter
  - C. Certificate of Business Registration
- O Contact the local Korean Embassy/Consulate to see if they require additional documents that you must provide in addition to the ones that SeoulTech provides you.

#### $\Box$ Apply for a student visa : Right after getting the Acceptance Packages from SeoulTech

- $\bigcirc$  Processing time for the visa issuance : About 20 ~ 50 days
  - \* It depends on each consulate. So you should be in a hurry to apply for a student visa.

#### □ Submission of the additional documents: Before 18 August 2023

- Submission of additional required documents
  - A. Health clearance form: Refer to the attached [Form 2] \* Only dormitory residents need to submit
  - B. Flight info (Fill out the itinerary information and upload the ticket on the webpage)
  - C. Copy of Korea visa (Please make it clear to see all personal information easily.)

#### <Students from Non-OECD conturies>

- D. A certificate of bank statement(balance)
- F. A certificate of enrollment(issued by home university)
  - : This document should be notarized by the embassy of Korea or Apostilled.

- In July 2023, we will send you the course list for the 2023 Fall semester about 7 days before the course enrollment. You are supposed to submit your course wish-list form within 2~3 days after getting an information about a finalized course list in July. \* Please check your email frequently.
- Before getting the updated course list or the 2023 fall semester, you can refer to the 2022 English-taught course List temporarily.

#### □ Dormitory Request

- SeoulTech only guarantee Sunglim dormitory room to exchange students.
- Please note that there is very few international hall quota and the previous residents have a priority to stay at the same room for the consequent semester. In this regard we will only receive a waiting list for international hall from the accepted students after the application result is announced. It will be very slim chance for a new residents to be assigned to the international hall. We can guarantee Sunglim dormitory room but we do NOT guarantee the international hall.
- There is no kitchen at the Sunglim dormtiroy room, if you need a kitchen, we highly recommend you to find other accommodation off campus.
- $\bigcirc$  A dormitory will not serve you the linens, pillow, and blankets.

#### $\Box$ Room Assignment – How?

○ Please note that the dormitory office will randomly assign a room. If there is a specific roommate with who you want to share a room, please leave a message on the application form.

#### Tuberculosis test Result

- Online Submission \* [Form 2] Health Clearance form
  - Link: http://for-a.seoultech.ac.kr/exchange
  - Submission Deadline: Before 18 August 2023
  - Only dormitory residents are required to submit
  - Only TB test result dated which performed after June 2023 is acceptable.
- O You can take any type of TB test result. (Chest X-ray test, Blood test, or Skin test)
- $\bigcirc$  Do not get confused with "Positive" and "Negative"
  - Please note that "Positive" means you have tuberculosis.
  - Only the students who have a "Negative" result can stay in the dormitory.
- $\bigcirc$  Without the TB test result, you can not stay in the dormitory.
  - For the safety of all dormitory residents, those who will stay at a dormitory must submit a TB-test result before check in
  - It doesn't matter that you are vaccinated or not. There is no exception.

#### $\Box$ Dormitory payment

- After your check-in, you will receive an invoice from the dormitory office. You should pay the fees at NH Bank, which is located on our campus.
- $\bigcirc$  You can pay it by cash(or transfer) but not by credit card.



# $\bigcirc$ Facilities


- In Room: Desk, bookshelf, bed, chair, fan, Internet access

# □ Dormitory Room Architecture Plan(Sunglim Dormitory)


- $\bigcirc$  Female students : Sunglim Women's Dormitory
  - Double room with no kitchen
  - 2 female students share a room



- $\bigcirc$  Male students : Sunglim Men's Dormitory
  - Triple room with no kitchen
  - 3 male students share a room
  - \* Triple Room = Room 1(1 student stay at a Room1 + Room 2(2 students stay at a Room2)

#### Visa

#### □ Online Submission

- Link: http://for-a.seoultech.ac.kr/exchange
- Before 18 August 2023

#### $\Box$ Apply for a student visa (D-2-6/ D-2-8)

- A student visa (D-2) is required to study in Korea if a student is not of Korean nationality.
- Please contact your nearest Korean Embassy or consulate for more detailed information on the visa application process.
- Be aware that students cannot change their visitor visa to a student visa in Korea. You should apply for a student visa (D-2-6/ D-2-8)
- The ministry of justice launched a now regulations as of June, 2022 and strengthened a immigration policy. They require additional materials for exchange students from Non-OECD countries.
  - \* Students from OECD countries : Normally the three documents(Ceertificate of admission, Acceptance letter, Certificate of business registration) will be sufficient to apply for a student visa.(D-2-6)
  - \* Students from Non-OECD countries : The ministry of justice strengthened an immigration policy and requires additional materials even for exchange students.
  - A certificate of bank statement(balance) : The bank statement should cover your exchange study semester living cost.(USD 4,000 for one semester/ USD 8,000 for one academic year).
  - A certificate of enrollment of home university : It should be Apostilled or notarized by the embassy of Korea in your country.

#### $\Box$ Processing time for the visa issuance

- $\bigcirc$  About 20  $\sim$  50days \* It depends on each consulate.
- Some times, it takes more time. So please apply for the visa right after getting the Acceptance Packages SeoulTech.

# National Health Insurance Service (NHIS)

- International students staying in Korea are automatically registered for the National Health Insurance (mandatory, no separate application required) as of March 1, 2021.
- However, students (D-2) who are entering Korea for the first time are registered from the date of alien registration. (not the date of entry to Korea). When you are registered, NHIS Card and Subscription Guide are sent to your residential address in Korea.
- National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) bill will be mailed to the residential addresses that you reported to the immigration office. You must pay the insurance fee by the 25th of every month
  - Insurance Benefits : The same benefits as the Korean citizens
  - Inquiry : +82-33-811-2000 (English, Chinese, Vietnamese and available)

# (Foreigner) Registration Card\_ ARC

### $\Box$ Group Application

○ We partner with a visa agency(hirevisa) that will help student to apply for ARC application and submit the documents to the immigration center on behalf of students. This service, however, costs a fee of KRW 40,000 (including 10,000 KRW application commition fee).

### $\Box$ Independent Application

○ You can, of course, also visit the Immigration Office independently. we recommend students to make a reservation at the immigration center right after entering to Korea.

### □ Required documents for issuing the (Foreigner)Registration Card.

- A. Registration Card Application form
- B. Processing fee: KRW 30,000
- C. Certificate of enrollment of SeoulTech
- D. A copy of passport
- E. Confirmation of visa Issuance
- F. 3.5 X 4.5 Photo

- We highly recommend you to bring a printed out photo. Taking a photo in Korea will cost about KRW 17,000.

#### G. Confirmation of Residence

- (Dormitory residents) : A certificate of dormitory residency

### - (Non-dormitory residents)

- a. Confirmation of Residence -Accommodation form
- b. Documents of evidence regarding ownership of the provided property: Certified Copy of Busidness Register, Residential Lease Agreement, etc.
- c. Copy of accommodation provider ID Card
