- 5. Copy of passport
- 6. Proof of meningitis vaccine (if under 22 years of age)
- 7 Immigration & Financial Requirements Form

Please note: An admissions decision cannot be determined until all official documents have been received. Only applications submitted by the home university will be processed.

Compulsory Language Requirement

Minimum test scores required for admission consideration:

• **TOEFL**: 79 ibt

• TOEIC: 650 and above

Note: Official TOEFL and TOEIC scores must be submitted by ETS (UIW institutional code 6303), copies will not be accepted.

• **IELTS**: 6.5

Note: Please send a copy of your IELTS scores. Official IELTS scores are not required.

• Cambridge English: 6.5 Advanced (CAE): C1 Level (Grade C)

Note: Official CAE scores must be submitted directly by the testing agency, copies will not be accepted.

Pre-Registration

Once admitted to UIW, all exchange students must submit 4 courses and 3 alternative courses. Exchange students may only enroll in undergraduate courses (levels 1000-4000). Courses will be submitted to the Academic Advising Center for processing. Class enrollment is on a first come first serve basis.

Requesting Transcripts & Release Dates

The Office of the Registrar will issue official transcripts of a student's academic record, including courses, grades, GPA, and degree upon request of the student. Transcripts can only be released directly to the student or to a person or entity designated by the student. There is a **\$2.90 service fee** per transcript, with a limit up of 5 per order. Students may request a digital copy or paper copy mailed via post.

Please note: We suggest you do *not* request a transcript until *after* grades are posted (please see Academic Calendar). Be sure to check with the Business Office & the Office of the Registrar to see if you have any holds. Transcripts will not be released until all holds are removed.

Visa	Accepted exchange students will receive a DS-2019 (Certificate of Eligibility) from UIW's International Student & Scholar Services. An information packet will be mailed with this form including details on the next steps to take to apply for a student visa.
International Ambassador Program	Upon arrival at UIW, you will be paired with a globally minded student who will help you adjust to life at UIW as well as provide peer support, guidance, and resources.
Health Insurance	All students are required to purchase international health insurance from UIW <i>only</i> . Cost is approximately \$700.00 USD per semester. Other insurance will not be accepted.
Proof of Meningitis Vaccine	All students (Domestic & International) must submit proof of a Meningitis Vaccine with their application if they are under the age of 22.
Housing	A representative from International Admissions will contact the student regarding university housing once the admissions application has been approved.
